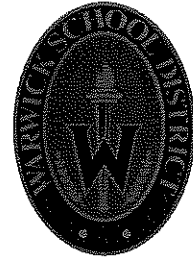


THE ACADEMY AT WARWICK



Registration Information

1. Complete a **SEPARATE** registration form for each participating student.
2. **Grade levels included with the course information are for the 2009/2010 school year.**
3. Please make checks payable to: *The Warwick School District* for the full amount. No cash payments will be accepted. **SEPARATE CHECKS REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS/STUDENT.**
4. An additional \$25.00 non-resident fee will be charged for those students residing outside the Warwick School District.
5. Mail the completed registration 20 S. Cedar Street, Lititz, PA 17543. The deadline for all enrichment course registrations is Friday, June 12, 2009.
6. All rules and regulations of the Warwick School District will be in effect during the Academy. Any disciplinary offence will terminate a student's enrollment. Tuition will not be refunded for a suspension.

Limited Enrollment

1. All classes have limited enrollments that vary according to the type of activities planned and grade levels involved. Class availability will be on a "first come-first served" basis.
2. Classes will be held in air-conditioned classrooms at the Lititz Elementary School. Students will be directed to classrooms during the first day of each session.
3. Classes are offered for students entering grades 1-6. All grade levels are based on the grade the student will be going in September 2009.

Cancellations

1. Parents can assume that their child is enrolled in the classes requested unless notified of a cancellation or change.
2. Checks will be returned for those classes that are cancelled due to insufficient enrollment and for those parent cancellations made by June 26, 2009.
3. If a student withdraws or is removed from a course, **no** refund will be given.
4. Partial refunds cannot be made if a student is not able to attend all scheduled classes.
