Josh Montpetit Memorial Scholarship – The Josh Montpetit Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to an individual who has had to face challenges whether health related or a learning disability, while living a full and productive life with a love of life in spite of those challenges. To complete for the scholarship an essay needs to be written paralleling your life to Josh and why you deserve to be recognized as the scholarship recipient. The Counseling Office and Montpetit Family will read all essays and determine the winner. There is a cover page in the Counseling Office that will need to be attached to your essay. **Deadline: April 30, 2018.**

Warwick Education Scholarship Application (WEA) – This scholarship is open to any Warwick High School senior who is pursuing a career in education. Completed scholarships should be turned in to Mr. Neuman (Room A257). **Deadline: April 13, 2018.**

Robert E. Behmer Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or above and planning to major in engineering at an accredited college. This is a one-time \$5,000 award given to a Warwick student. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. **Deadline: April 16, 2018.**

The William and Shirley Bell Teacher Education Scholarship is a one-time award given to a Warwick Senior who is planning to pursue a degree in education. Criteria are overall GPA, Attendance, Participation in school activities, and Community Service work. This award given in memory of Mr. Bell's father is a \$1000 scholarship. Applications are due in the Counseling Office by **April 30, 2018.**

Christopher P. Mitchell Memorial Scholarship – This \$500 scholarship is in memory of Christopher P. Mitchell, a 1988 graduate of Warwick High School. Students must have a 3.0 or better GPA, be a member of a Warwick athletic team and plan to attend a 4 year college. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. **Deadline: April 15, 2018.**

The Jen Shetter Memorial Scholarship (Smile 4 Me) is awarded to a student who is planning to attend college to become a teacher with an emphasis on elementary education. This award is in memory of Jen Shetter whose passionate love for teaching and children was evident in her classroom. Applications for this scholarship are available in the Counseling Office and are due in the Counseling Office by **April 21, 2018.**

The Lititz Lodge #1050 Independent Order of Odd Fellows is advertising five one-time \$1,000 scholarships. These scholarships are for students who have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA and will be enrolling in a school of post-secondary education (two-year or four-year). Completed applications must be returned to the Counseling Office by **April 27, 2018.**
