A student must have at least a 2.0 GPA and \$55,000 or lower adjusted gross family income. Scholarships can range in award value from \$5,000 to \$20,000. Applications will be judged on scholarship, leadership and financial need. **Deadline: November 5, 2019.**

Lititz Women of Today Andrew T. Bolton Memorial Scholarship for Vocational or Technical School – Students must have at least a 3.0 GPA and be planning to attend a vocational or technical school. This is a \$500 one-time scholarship. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. **Deadline: April 30, 2020.**

Lititz Women of Today Scholarship for Volunteerism- Eligible students must include at least one significant volunteer activity where they have participated. This is a one-time \$500 scholarship. Applications are available in the Counseling Office. **Deadline: April 30, 2020.**
