NOTICE TO ALL NON-PUBLIC STUDENTS and CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY STUDENTS:

Non-public school districts in the area start as early as August 23, 2016 for the 16/17 school year. Warwick School District has a start date of September 7, 2016 for the 16/17 school year. Warwick School District buses will not be running until September 7, 2016, students will need to be transported to Warwick High School to board their respective buses. In the PM, non-public students will be transported to a stop located near their home location.

Beginning Wednesday, September 7, 2016, non-public students have the option of being transported to Warwick High School on a Warwick secondary bus transporting public school students living in your area. Students who walk or are driven to the high school should arrive prior to 7:15 AM in order for non-public buses to depart at 7:20 AM.

CAREER & TECHNOLOGY CENTER STUDENTS:

Transportation will be provided from Warwick High School to Willow Street, Mt. Joy and Brownstown Career and Technology Centers beginning August 29, 2016. However, since the Warwick School District buses will not be running until September 7, 2016, students will need to be transported to/from the high school to board the bus to the Career & Technology Centers. The bus for Willow Street and Mt. Joy leaves Warwick High School promptly at 7:35 AM, and the bus to Brownstown leaves the Warwick High School promptly at 7:40 AM. Students are responsible for transportation to and from Warwick High School from August 29-September 7, 2016.
