



WARWICK Athletic HALL of FAME

Guidelines

New inductees to the Hall of Fame will be added annually at a home football game.

After the initial year, there will be 4-5 added the following years based on the committee's voting.

Warwick will only nominate and induct individuals, not teams. The committee has the right to consider opening it up to teams in the future.

Nominations will be accepted throughout the year. The deadline to be considered for the upcoming Hall of Fame class is May 31.

Nominees can be athletes, coaches, or other individuals from the community that have contributed to the Warwick athletic program.

Individuals are permitted to nominate relatives, as well as themselves. The form will not require the nominator to provide his/her name.

Student athletes must have graduated from high school at least 5 years ago to be considered. There is no waiting period for coaches or other nominees.

In addition to being recognized permanently in the gym lobby on a large screen TV above the trophy cases, there will be a reception on the night of the induction. This will typically be held on campus a couple hours before the game, and it is open to the public to attend for a small fee.

The inductees will be announced at halftime of the selected football game.

Once all of the nominations are received, the selected committee will be given a packet that lists each candidate and a short bio.

After an individual is nominated, he/she will automatically be included in the packet in future years until they have been inducted.

If a selected individual has passed away or no longer lives in the area and can't attend the ceremony, the family will be contacted to find a representative.

Starting in 2015, the Hall of Fame committee will select one individual from the time period before Warwick High School was opened (before 1956-57 school year) to be included with the other inductees. If anyone has the name and/or information about an individual from before Warwick High School opened, please send the information to the athletic director via email or complete the regular Hall of Fame nomination form.
