1. Presentation – Vietnam Veterans (*former Warwick School District Graduates*)
~ Ms. Sherry Ruggiero

Ms. Ruggiero shared the experience offered to students over the past six years, in which Veterans, who were all former Warwick School District Graduates, visit Warwick and present in panel form. Students ask the Veteran's questions, Veterans bring artifacts, and students get to meet individually with Veterans following their discussion. Veterans are given flowers and thanked for their service. Students then write letters to the Veterans following their visit. This year Ms. Ruggiero created a memorial for a Veteran who died this past year, who had previously visited Warwick, and was fondly remembered. Ms. Ruggiero shared what an honor it has been for her and the students to host the Veterans who have served our country.

2. School Safety and Security Practices Report
~ Dr. Ryan Axe & Chief John Schofield

Dr. Axe provided an overview of the safety initiatives, which have been added over the past two years. These safety initiatives included: cameras on buses, additional installation of cameras in the building, updates to the phone system, labeling of doors, improvements to the entrance system for employees, emergency button installation, fully implemented Safe to Say at the middle school and high school levels, hiring of the SRO, student wellness instruction, community awareness related to resilience, Gate Guardians, etc. Moving forward we are working on facility dogs in all buildings. Warwick is always looking to improve security to insure the safety of all students and staff.
