- 2. Student Representative Report - *Zoe Wiker* Feedback around elementary spirit days, fill a cruiser, at High School feedback on the trimester day.
- 3. A Better Way Athletics - *Mr. Heath Eslinger (virtual)*
 - a. This is a follow-up to the previous presentation from the October Committee of the Whole meeting. Instruction, tools and resources, ongoing support / rolling curriculum - 2-3 minute videos / where, safety, belonging and trust are evident / three year contract \$17,600 / curriculum is customizable to Warwick / Discussion about whether coaches have seen this yet - not yet / discussion about other providers for this service - best when discussed with other districts / discussion around what other districts use A Better Way Athletics - Ephrata and Penn Manor / PD for coaches / Concern about level of obligations for coaching which is possibly the reason we have a hard time hiring and retaining coaches / this is a tool for the coaches not an additional burden or weight for the coaches / years of service doesn't equate to no need for PD / Would like us to negotiate the three year contract to less commitment financially / possible survey coaches for their needs / ask A Better Way if they have mentorship tools / decision to come back to this committee again for final decision prior to going back to the goal (decision in January)
- 4. Extra-Curricular Report - *Mr. Earl Hazel* Huge list of awards / Moving to an electronic paperwork platform for physicals / No additional cost
