1. Welcome and Public Comment

- a. Mr. Bob Daecher: Concern was raised about the lack of handicap parking spots near the athletic fields. Mr. Daecher requested that the 4 handicap parking spots be expanded to 12.

2. HS renovation – Lobar Change Order #41 roof work in the amount of \$62,092.42

- a. Part of Tour
- b. The committee reviewed videos of the roof and knee wall. The roof was originally replaced as part of the current renovation project. After the roof was completed, leaks were identified above the newly renovated girls' locker room. Upon investigation, it was determined that the roof was not causing the water leaks; rather, the problem was a knee wall that was part of the 2003 HS Renovation project. The proposed solution in change order #41 is to cover the wall with rubber, similar to the roof, to prevent water penetration. The WSD maintenance crew has temporarily installed a rubber tarp over the wall to minimize the water intrusion. Mr. Weber has met with 3 roof restoration vendors to review the roof and knee wall, and all provided quotes similar to or more expensive than the change order. Lobar is on-site and able to start work by end of May.

3. Tour of HS Renovation area

- b. Dr. Szobocsan reviewed the newly renovated bathrooms, which included accessibility for one-to-one needs and a faculty bathroom. 8 toilets were installed along the wall. Each toilet will be blocked off with floor-to-ceiling walls. This bathroom will look identical on the second floor above. The sinks include soap, water, and hand dryers, eliminating the need for paper towels.
