COMMUNITY MEMBERS PRESENT: (LNP: Ashley Stahlnecker)

1. Welcome and Public Comment
 - Mrs. Snyderman welcomed everyone and introduced Mrs. Dombach to present the Food & Nutrition Services Budget.
2. 2026-2027 Food & Nutrition Services Budget
 - The 26-27 Budget projects a slight deficit of \$4,542
 - Current budget includes increasing the following prices:
 - Elementary lunch price would increase \$.10 to \$2.85
 - Secondary lunch price would increase \$.10 to \$3.10
 - Adult breakfast price would increase \$.10 to \$3.10
 - Adult lunch price would increase \$.15 to \$5.00
 - Milk price would increase \$.15 to \$.65
 - Current budget projects increases in the following expenditures:
 - Wages increased 13.1% compared to the 25-26 Budget due to higher wages and full staffing.
 - Food purchases increased 2%
 - Non-food supplies increased 85% to a total of \$61,398 to align with trends
 - Small equipment expenditures increased as most kitchen equipment is aging and in need of replacement
 - Discussed at length current bad debt and regulations regarding
 - Approximately \$35,000 in lunch debt
3. 2026-2027 Final General Fund Budget
 - Changes from the Proposed Final budget included
 - Expenditures and Revenues increased \$561,335
 - Revenue changes:
 - Final assessment from County, increased real estate revenue \$341,613
 - Increases in Transportation subsidy

Next meeting: **September 15, 2026 @ 5:15 p.m.**

- Increases in Real Estate Transfer tax and other local revenue
- Expenditure Changes:
 - Increases in professional staff wages for column movement
 - Increases in other staff wages for increases in custodial rates as well as increases in OT for vacant positions
 - Decreases in workers' compensation and property/ liability insurance due to final renewal quotes received
 - Increases in medical/ dental expenses to align to trends
 - Increase in WVA tuition and supplies to align with cost increases
- 4. WarwickWare Fund
 - Informational item discussed regarding potentially dissolving the WarwickWARE fund and running operations in the General Fund to consolidate transactions and recognize District's expense
- 5. Board Recommendations Recap
 - It is recommended that the Board approve the 2026-27 Food and Nutrition Services budget as presented on ATTACHMENT #__. (Note: The budget continues to reflect free breakfasts for all students and free lunch for reduced-price students. The budget also includes increasing student lunch prices by 10¢.)
