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1. Penn Medicine Healthworks Presentation ~ *Keith Fox, Director Employer Relations & Strategic Growth*

Provides membership based primary care. Removes copay for members. Provides primary care, urgent care, rapid point of care, and pharmaceutical provider. 8 locations reach 88% of employees. Outlined proposed membership roll-out. Cost savings through redacted in billed claims, decreased substitute expenses, and improved proactive health care.
