- 1. Welcome and Public Comment No comments

- 2. Audit Update Mr. Wertsch provided an overview of the 2019-20 audit that is ongoing. Mr. Wertsch shared information related to the General Fund Year End Snapshot, with the June 30, 2018 and June 30 2019 General Fund Year End Snapshot. He then reviewed the current (August, 2020) General Fund Commitments that include PSERS/Health Care Stabilization, Future Operating Expenses, Construction and Improvement, and Capital Expenditures, all of which are part of the Total Committed Fund Balance (total of \$12.750M). The current amount of Uncommitted Funds is \$5.58M, or 7.4%. The proposed transfer includes savings through bond refinancing (\$402K), budgeted capital reserve transfers (\$660K), unused budgetary reserve (\$250K), favorability in health insurance (\$2.1M), transportation/utility savings from the building shutdowns (\$414K), and revenue favorability (\$1M). The recommendation is to transfer \$4,983,498 to the Capital Reserve Fund and commit an additional \$500,000 in the general fund to Construction and Improvements. This would take the Capital Reserve Fund balance to \$14.4M from the current balance of \$9.4M. A conversation with the committee followed about when the Committed Fund Balance and Capital Reserve Funds would be used.

Board Recommendations: It is recommended that the board approve the following 2019-20 general fund balance commitments:

3. 2020-21 Budget Transfers - Mr. Wertsch presented the current 2020-21 budget transfers for review to the committee.
