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**Be Respectful:**

- Be kind.
- Keep your microphone muted unless you are called upon or working in small groups.
- Raise your virtual hand to talk, or enter a question into the chat box and wait patiently for your teacher to respond.
- When dressing for the school-day, remember to be respectful of yourself and others. Students should present themselves in a scholarly, intellectual, and appropriate manner, while still expressing a sense of individuality and style. Clothing should not cause a distraction to the learning environment. If this occurs, it could result in a disciplinary infraction.

**Be Responsible:**

- Ask questions if you need clarification.
- Engage in the questions from your teacher in order for them to understand what you know.
- Complete all tasks as assigned.
- Separate school time from social time, close out social media sites and turn your phone off.

**Be Ready:**

- You are encouraged to wake in time for a morning routine, including time to eat breakfast before your first class so that you are alert and ready for learning. In addition, please adhere to your lunch schedule to take a break and to focus on healthy nutritional choices.
- Choose a good location. Find a location that has few distractions.
- Be punctual, and be logged in 5 minutes prior to class starting, when feasible.
- Have your materials nearby (pencils, paper, textbooks, homework). Use the same positive study habits you used when in the school building such as taking notes and keeping your materials organized.
- Think about what is in the shared screen behind you, make sure it is school appropriate.
